Welcome to the Annual Report of The Pentecostal Assembly School for the academic year 2023-24.

- **NEW SESSION COMMENCEMENT:** The new academic session commenced on 3rd April 2023 ,marking the beginning of another year of growth , learning and excellence.
- **ENVIRONMENT EDUCATION :** ‘Green Initiatives’; Throughout the year, our school continued its commitment to environmental sustainability through various initiatives.To create awareness among students Earth Day was celebrated throughout the sections from Std. Nursery to Std..XII.Students took pledge to keep their surroundings clean and also took pledge to beat plastic pollution. They also participated in the Slogan Writing and Poster Making Competition. The students of Grades 6- 12 added colors to their imaginations on the canvas and wonderfully presented the topic “ The beauty of the green world” through Canvas Painting Competition. Special Assemblies were held through the sections to raise environmental awareness. A poster-making competition further engaged students, promoting responsibility towards the environment. Earth **Day** was celebrated on 21st April 2023 for the students of Nursery to 2. Students also participated in a colouring competition organised on the occasion.ent with themes like "Save Water," "Save Tree," and "Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle." The school also conducted an inspiring cleanliness drive on October 1st ,2023 to mark the eve of Mahatma Gandhi’s birth anniversary ,under the ‘Swachata Hi Seva’ Campaign.
- **SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS:** Our students showcased remarkable talent and sportsmanship in various inter-school and intra-school competitions. From athletics to team sports, our athletes excelled, bringing numerous accolades and trophies.The 33rd Annual Sports Day in December demonstrated spirit, enthusiasm, and determination despite inclement weather. Aqsa Firdaus of VIII C secured the top spot in the Girls Under 13 Single Championship .Anjali Kumari of VIB secured Silver Medal in 6th Open National Taekwondo Championship 2023.Inter House Cricket Competition , Basketball Competition, Kabaddi Contest and Volleyball Competition were held for the students of Std.6 - 12
- **INNOVATIONS:** The school held a captivating Science Experiment Demonstration exhibiting the inventive capabilities of students from classes VI-VIII and IX -X.An innovative Science quiz was conducted for the junior minds of classes 3-5.Notable accomplishments include the recognition of PAS students in the National Children's Science Congress 2022, hosted by the National Council of Science and Technology Communications, Department of Science and Technology, Government of India.
- **OVERALL RESULTS:**
Academic Excellence: The dedication and hard work of our students, coupled with the guidance of our faculty, led to outstanding academic achievements. The school achieved commendable results in board examinations and other academic assessments, reflecting our commitment to excellence in education. PAS students shine brightly in AISSE 2022-23 with exceptional results.Out of 134 pupils, 19 earned 95% or higher, while one-third achieved 90% or above.The topper of the school was Prachi Choudhary,who scored 99%.In AISSCE 2023 , in a batch of 199 students 37 students scored a high of 90% and above. Deshna Jain from the Commerce Stream topped the institution by securing a phenomenal 96%.Sujal Kumar topped the Science Stream with 95.4% where as Simran Kant topped the Arts Section with 95.4%..

The students of The Pentecostal Assembly School proved themselves with their top notch results at JEE (MAINS) 2023. 19 students (18.26 %) out of the current batch of 104 who appeared for the JEE MAINS 2023 have qualified with high scores so far.

Sujal Kumar and Sumit Kumar Mahatha brought laurels to the school by their laudable performance in JEE (ADVANCE). Students also showcased their meritorious success in National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET). Prem Kumar Vishwakarma of 12 A secured 625 rank in his first attempt in Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) 2023-24. He scored 92.5 out of 118 marks in his first attempt to National Law University. PAS alumnus Varsha Kumari Secures Rank 353 in Civil Services Exam. The Pentecostal alumnus CA Pulkit Jain Shines Bright in his First Attempt! In a remarkable showcase of mathematical prowess, three students namely Shazia Mokarram and Arpan Kumar of Grade X and Arush Prakash of Grade IX from The Pentecostal Assembly School, B.S. City, have emerged as the top 100 meritorious students in the prestigious Aryabhata Ganit Challenge (AGC)-2023, organized by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

The Pentecostal Assembly School students also excelled in the ASSET exam and were recognised by the ASSET team. The SAFAL assessment for the academic year 2022-23 was successfully conducted for grades 5 and 8, with a total participation strength of 234 students. This year, in the session 2023-24, we introduced EI Cares. EI Cares is an assessment tool that formulates customized assessment programs aligned with the school curriculum and provides immediate, detailed feedback on individual student performance. This initiative perfectly aligns with the New Education Policy 2020, with a key focus on skill-based and competency-based assessment for grades 6 to 9 in key curricular areas such as English Language, Mathematics, Social Science, and Science, with a total student strength of 484 in the session 2023-24.

- PTM ACTIVITIES:

Regular Parent-Teacher Meetings served as valuable opportunities for constructive dialogue and collaboration between parents and teachers. These sessions facilitated a deeper understanding of each student's progress, strengths, and areas for improvement, fostering a supportive learning environment.
