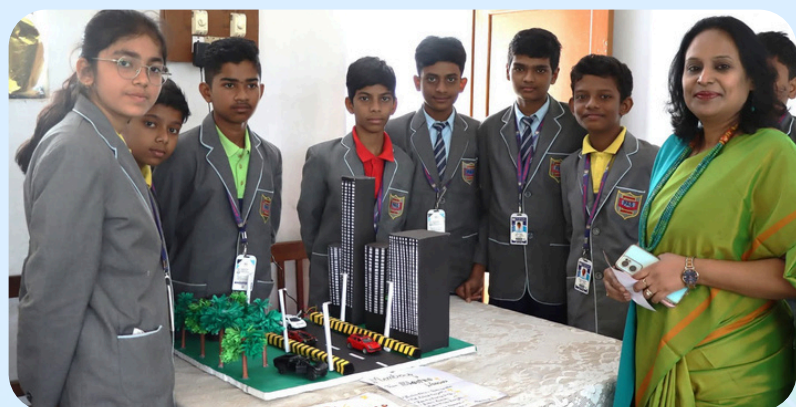

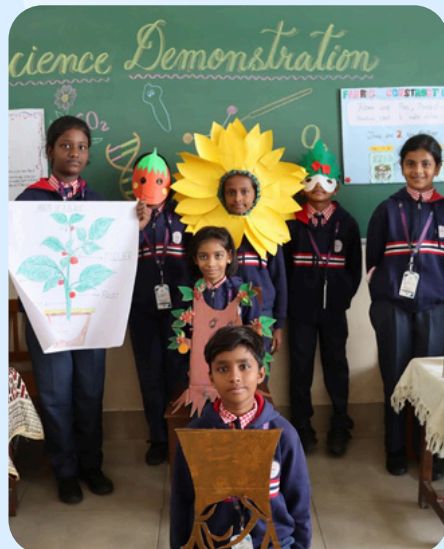




Science Comes Alive at PAS Primary Wings
